SHOW RULES

COMPETITORS ARE REQUIRED TO READ AND ABIDE BY THE SHOW RULES LISTED ON THIS FLYER.

ALL ENTRANTS IN CLASSES 1 - 5 MUST BE REGISTERED BY 8:50 AM.

1. Show clothes not required. Boots must be worn in all classes for safety. Hard hats are required for all English Classes. **Based on Florida Law: All riders under the age of 16 must wear an ASTM Safety Helmet while mounted and while riding. USE OF HELMETS, FOR ALL RIDERS, OF ALL AGES, IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.**
2. No spurs or whips in **GAME** classes. No martingales or tie-downs allowed **except in GAME classes.** Schooling Aids allowed in English & Western Schooling classes. (draw reins, 2 hands on reins).
3. Current (less than 1 year old) **Negative Coggins** required, either original or notarized copy.
4. Junior exhibitors are those who have not reached their 16th birthday as of the show date. **For 3 show series,** if you begin the series as a junior, you remain a Junior for all 3 shows, regardless of whether you have turned 16.
5. All entries must be completed and signed before numbers are assigned. Each horse-rider combo equals 1 entry /1 number. A Parent or guardian must sign entries for all competitors under age 18. **MAKE SURE YOU HAVE THE CORRECT NUMBER OR AUDIT TAG ON WHEN YOU ENTER THE RING!**
6. **"AUDITED"** (non-judged) riders will be identified with BLUE TAGS.
7. The gate will close two minutes after the first horse enters the ring. Arrange tack changes in advance.
8. **LEAD LINE** - MAXIMUM AGE IS 8 YEARS OLD. Exhibitor (rider) cannot enter any other class in show.
9. **WALK-TROT/JOG CLASSES:** No cross-entry by **RIDER (regardless of horse)**, between **Walk-Trot/Jog Classes & Canter/Lope** classes permitted, except for auditing & Open Classes.
10. **Walk:** No cross-entry by **RIDER (regardless horse)**, between **Walk class** and **Trot/Jog-Canter/Lope classes**, except for auditing, Open Classes.
Walk class: Riders will walk, halt, & negotiate cones.

Each horse/rider combo can enter only 1 trail class. No cross entry between Walk, Trot/Jog or Canter/Lope

Walk Trail Class: Riders will compete on a Trail course at a walk.

Trail Classes – Riders in Trail Class may not **"AUDIT"** Walk-Trail Class.

Walk/Trot Riders will compete on a Trail course at 2 gaits, Canter/Lope Riders will compete at all three gaits

NEW RULE: **FOR ALL TRAIL CLASSES: 2 Refusals by your horse and you must move off the obstacle.**

11. **POINTS:** Junior & Senior Hi Point & Reserve to be awarded at end of show. *Rider* accumulates points. All classes to count towards Hi Point, **EXCEPT CLASSES WITH AN ASTERISK ON THE CLASS LIST:**

12. Show officials reserve the right to disqualify any horse or rider from the show whose groom, owner, or their families display any act of discourtesy, disobedience or improper handling. Management will not be liable for compensation or damage. Any class may be canceled, divided or combined at the discretion of Management.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

SCHOOLING CLASSES: Open to all horses. Schooling equipment allowed – running martingales, splint boots, draw reins, 2 hands on reins, etc. Any questions, see the judge. These classes do not count toward high point or reserve.

FUN COSTUME: Dress yourself, dress your horse! **Entrants will be judged on creativity, originality & presentation.**

EGG & SPOON CHALLENGE: Riders **WALK/TROT** while holding an egg in spoon. Fingers cannot go below black line.

RIBBON PAIRS: Two horses & riders enter as a pair. Riders will hold a ribbon between them while executing **ALL GAITS.**

POLE BENDING: Riders will execute the Pole Bending pattern at a **TROT ONLY.** Faster gait will be eliminated. **Timed event.**

RIDE-A-BUCK: ALL GAITS - Bareback ride w/YOUR dollar tucked under leg. Last rider with buck still in place wins all the bucks.
